

We also work with the ALS Association nationally to raise funds for research and to advocate on issues affecting people with ALS.

FACTS ABOUT ALS

- ALS stands for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and is commonly known as Lou Gehrig's Disease
- Every 90 minutes someone is diagnosed with ALS, and every 90 minutes someone loses their battle to this fatal disease
- The average life span after diagnosis is 2-5 years
- Military veterans are twice as likely as the general population to die from ALS
- Living with ALS can cost more than \$200,000 per year above and beyond what is covered by insurance
