

This Walk to Defeat® represents hope and support to the hundreds of people in the Greater Sacramento Chapter's region. When you walk, you are not helping only your loved one, but everyone in our community who is affected by ALS, now and in the future.

Every year, hundreds of people in our community whose lives have been affected by ALS borrow durable medical equipment from our loan closet, participate in our support and resource groups, receive the highest level of care at our ALS Certified Treatment Centers of Excellence, and call on our patient services staff for resource referrals and home visits. We also work with the ALS Association nationally to raise funds for research and to advocate on issues affecting people with ALS.

FACTS ABOUT ALS

- ALS stands for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and is commonly known as Lou Gehrig's Disease
- Every 90 minutes someone is diagnosed with ALS, and every 90 minutes someone loses their battle to this fatal disease
- The average life span after diagnosis is 2-5 years
- Military veterans are twice as likely as the general population to die from ALS
- Living with ALS can cost more than \$200,000 per year above and beyond what is covered by insurance
